



Camps for Children with Autism

Breakaway provides respite camps for children with autism.

Autism camps provide three days of fun and socialising, including accommodation, meals and age appropriate activities.

The camps are supported by Certificate III and IV carers in disability and volunteers trained in the care of children with disabilities.

The purpose of the camps is -

- To provide an opportunity for children with Autism to have fun in a safe caring environment.
- To provide a range of activities for the child with Autism that are new, challenging and exciting. The program will encourage self-expression, independence and promote a sense of self-worth and confidence.
- To give the child with Autism the chance to meet other children with autism and form friendships.
- To promote a sense of self-worth and confidence.
- To give much-needed respite for parents and siblings.

Activities for children would include: a Scavenger hunt, movie night, disco, outside sporting activities, jumping pillow, tennis, putt putt golf and Nintendo Wii.

The camps are held at Camp Breakaway at San Remo and will be organised and run by our experienced staff. Please note: all staff have Working with Children and Police checks.

Breakaway is a registered charity that has been holding respite camps for children and adults with disabilities for the past 33 years. Camp Breakaway is located at San Remo, nestled in a tranquil bushland setting.
